
AUTHORIZED STATE BANKING HOLIDAYS FOR YEAR 2009

Pursuant to Section 1-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975, banks are authorized to observe the following holidays:

Birthdays of Robert E. Lee & Martin Luther King, Jr.	Monday, January 19, 2009
Birthdays of George Washington & Thomas Jefferson	Monday, February 16, 2009
Confederate Memorial Day	Monday, April 27, 2009
National Memorial Day	Monday, May 25, 2009
Jefferson Davis' Birthday	Monday, June 1, 2009
Independence Day*	Friday, July 3, 2009
Labor Day	Monday, September 7, 2009
Columbus Day	Monday, October 12, 2009
Veterans Day	Wednesday, November 11, 2009
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 26, 2009
Christmas Day*	Friday, December 25, 2009

*Banks are also authorized to close on Saturday, July 4, 2009; at 12:00 noon on Thursday, December 24, 2009 and Saturday, December 26, 2009; and at noon on Thursday, December 31, 2009.

State banks and branches of state banks located in Baldwin and Mobile Counties may, if they choose, observe Tuesday, February 24, 2009, Mardi Gras Day, as a holiday.
