Jefferson Davis' Birthday	Monday, June 4, 2012
Independence Day	Wednesday, July 4, 2012
Labor Day	Monday, September 3, 2012
Columbus Day	Monday, October 8, 2012
Veterans Day	Monday, November 12, 2012
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 22, 2012
Christmas Day	Tuesday, December 25, 2012*

\* Banks are also authorized to close on Monday, January 2, 2012, to close at noon on Monday, December 24, 2012, and to close at noon Monday, December 31, 2012.
