Dear Governor Riley:

I submit to you our 2007 fiscal year-end report to comply with the Code of Alabama 1975 § 5-2A-13.

I am pleased to report that Alabama, state-chartered banks grew over \$8 billion during this fiscal year. Today, we regulate 127 banks with total assets of over \$207 billion and offices in 18 host states and in foreign countries. Today, Alabamians still consider the financial service business a sound investment. We chartered 6 new banks to service Alabama residents and supervised the merger/consolidation of 2 of the nations' and Alabama's largest banks.

During this fiscal year, we chartered one new trust company. In addition to our 5 Alabama, state-chartered trust companies, we also regulate 13 bank trust departments. Combined, these 18 wealth management entities have amassed total customer assets under management of nearly \$98 billion.


Our Bureau of Loans' staff continues to actively regulate the non-deposit lending industry. Those licensees include consumer credit, pawnshops, small loan companies, deferred presentment services (payday lenders), and many mortgage brokers operating in Alabama. This Bureau now regulates over 4,000 licensees including 1,201 Deferred Presentment and 527 Mortgage Broker units.

Governor, while banks continue to consolidate through mergers, we now have the challenge of working through the recent American downturn of the real estate mortgage industry. This national slowdown and fallout will undoubtedly continue for some time with negative results for consumers, builders, lenders, and investors. Throughout this cycle our field examiners and office staff will continue to work efficiently and diligently dedicated to protect all of the citizens of Alabama and the 18 host states where our banks operate. In order to do so, we continue to maintain a solid working relationship with both our Federal and host-state banking/real estate mortgage regulators.

We value your active support of our department, your acceptance of our invitations to speak during various hosted events, and we look forward to continue working under your great leadership. In closing, we thank you and the legislature for your support and signature on the 2007 changes to the Alabama Banking Code that modernized and improved our overall supervisory abilities.

BUREAU OF BANKING

Established March 2, 1911, the Bureau of Banking charters and regulates banks, trust companies, and savings and loan associations. We currently have no state chartered savings and loans operating in Alabama. As of fiscal year-end September 30, 2007, the Banking Bureau had 127 commercial banks and 5 trust companies under supervision. During this same period, the Superintendent of Banks approved 6 new commercial bank charters.

State-chartered banks continue to dominate the Alabama commercial banking industry in number of banks, total assets and total deposits. Total assets and total deposits of state-chartered banks at fiscal year end amount to \$207,814,040 and \$144,912,084, respectively. Equity Capital for state-chartered banks totaled over \$33 billion with the ratio of Average Equity Capital to Total Assets remaining above 16%. Refer to our Consolidated Reports of Condition for more details.

BUREAU OF LOANS

The Bureau of Loans was established in 1945 under authority of Act No. 159, for the purpose of administering and enforcing the provisions of the Harris Act, the predecessor of the present **Alabama Small Loan Act of 1959** (§ 5-18-1 et seq. 1975 Code). Since that time, the Alabama legislature has expanded the consumer protection role of the Bureau through various additional acts.

In 1971, the Alabama legislature passed the **Alabama Consumer Credit Act** (§ 5-19-1 et seq. 1975 Code), commonly known as the Mini-Code, which designated the Superintendent of Banks as Administrator and the Supervisor of the Bureau of Loans as Deputy Administrator for enforcement purposes. The **Alabama Pawn Shop Act** was enacted into law on May 21, 1992, under the authority of Act No. 92-597 (§ 5-19A-1 et seq.). The **Mortgage Brokers Licensing Act** was enacted into Law on May 30, 2001, under the authority of Act No. 2001-692 (§ 5-25-1-et seq.) The **Deferred Presentment Services Act** was enacted into law on June 20, 2003, under the authority of Act No. 2003-359 (§ 5-18A-1 et seq.). All of these laws designate the Supervisor of the Bureau of Loans as the regulatory authority to administer and enforce the Acts.

The Bureau of Loans has the statutory authority to examine at any reasonable time the lending activity and other records of any small loan company, finance company, and/or other individuals or persons holding any license from the State Banking Department. Staff examiners normally review records and transactions to determine compliance with Alabama laws at the licensee's place of business. Each licensee pays to the State Banking Department the actual cost of each examination with the amount being reasonably prescribed under uniform and equitable rules and regulations promulgated by the Superintendent of Banks.
